My campaign theme is Keep St. James on the Right Track. For example, a project in partnership with Brunswick County to boost water pressure in St. James is scheduled to bring relief in the first half of next year.

A major project that will soon begin construction is St. James Center, a mixed-use development of 140 acres behind and beside the Town Hall and Event Center. The parcel likely will be annexed by the Town, which will be responsible for overseeing the development.
