



TOWN OF ST. JAMES HOMER E. WRIGHT EVENT CENTER SPACE NEEDS STUDY

September 5, 2025





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I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Town of St. James consist of a thriving and growing community. The Town Hall and Event Center, completed in 2010, has served the Town well. However, due to its success, the Event Center is no longer able to accommodate all resident requests for gathering space. After meeting with residents, management, and town council, it became evident that both the need for smaller spaces, for resident groups, must be coupled with the goal of the center continuing to function as a premier large event venue.

A few takeaways from the process include: The current caterers' kitchen and back of house amenities appear to function well for large events and can accommodate smaller resident gathers. Space between the Town Hall and the Event Center, while not used to its full potential, benefits both buildings with access to natural light and landscape. Parking near the building is desired but needs to allow for green space between the building and hardscape. The front facade of the Event Center, on the north side, consists of solid walls which is not overly inviting. Utilities around the building, including an 8" waster main easement, should be considered when locating any addition so funds can be directed toward usable building space. Resident population is aging; thus, universal design is critical to the success of any additions or renovations.

This study supports the need for an expansion of the event center to provide a variety of sized rooms that are flexible and able to support both smaller and larger events.

FINDINGS

A survey was developed by the design team and distributed to the Town of St. James for their input. See Appendix A for full survey data. After thorough analysis of the survey data, the following are key takeaways relevant to potential improvements or expansion of the Town of St. James' Homer E. Wrights Event Center:

AGE DISTRIBUTION

82% of respondents are 65 years old or older, with nearly 100% over the age of 44.

Implication: The facility primarily serves an older adult population. Future improvements should prioritize accessibility, comfort, and age-friendly design, i.e. better lighting, seating, and ADA-compliant features.

GROUP SIZE COMFORT

Responses were spread, but the plurality (33%) are most comfortable in groups of 30+, followed by 29% preferring 10-19 people.

Implication: There's a need for flexible spaces - large rooms for big events, but also configurations that accommodate more intimate gatherings without feeling sparse or overwhelming.

BARRIERS TO ACCESS

Common barriers include limited parking, poor nighttime lighting, dance floor space, accessibility concerns (heavy doors, handicapped parking), and ongoing construction or traffic.

Implication: These practical issues should be top priorities for near-term improvements. Consider better lighting, automatic doors, satellite parking with shuttles, and expanded ADA features.

BIGGEST ISSUES NEEDING RENOVATION OR ADDITION

Overwhelming emphasis on inadequate dance floor space, especially for line dancing. Also frequent: insufficient small meeting rooms, perceived poor AV/sound system, limited parking, and aesthetics or comfort.

Implication: The expansion must include the following:

- Sufficiently sized, high-quality wood dance floor
- Additional rooms for small-to-mid-size gatherings
- Upgraded AV equipment and soundproofing

LIKELIHOOD TO RECOMMEND TO OTHERS

Very high satisfaction - 81% "Very Likely" or "Likely" to recommend the event center.

Implication: The event center is appreciated as is but reinforcing that improvements need not be to overhaul the function or identity of the facility, rather provide more space and high quality experiences.

IMPORTANCE OF FACILITY FEATURES

Top Priorities are:

- Parking availability
- · Ability to accommodate activities of interest
- Ample space
- Security features

Lower Priorities are:

- Free Wi-Fi
- Environmentally friendly design
- Quiet study areas

Implication: Investments should target practicality and functionality first - space, flexibility, security - before less critical amenities.

IMPORTANCE OF ACTIVITIES

The Most Important Activities are:

- Educational seminars / classes
- Yoaa / dance / exercise
- Large and small group meetings
- Parties and events (dances, etc.)

Lower-rated Activities are:

- Quiet study areas
- Music Rooms

Implication: Any facility expansion should bolster multipurpose event and programming spaces.

RECOMMENDED ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

The common suggestions for additional activities are: More dance events, concerts, billiards / game room, educational programs, improved kitchen, cultural and theatrical performances, and expanded evening programming.

Implication: There is a strong interest in both active social uses and creative learning / cultural events. Flexible space design and thoughtful scheduling could support both.

The following pages illustrates the results of the Visual Preference Exercise, which resulted from choices made by public input session participants. Participants were asked to make their top three choices from a set of images. Along with those votes, they had the option of writing in alternatives.

The top 3 preferences were:

- 1. Non-Programmed Flex Spaces 27 votes
- 2. Catering Kitchen ("... more electrical outlets") 11 votes
- 3. Hospitality Area 9 votes

Participants' write-in comments were:

- Flexible room arrangements allow for smaller gathering spaces.
- Build flexibility into operating hours
- Regulate building temperatures better (often very cold in restrooms)
- Consider movable walls and furnishings to provide room layout options that offer some visual / sound attenuation as well as a variety of layouts for different activities.
- Add more task lighting in small rooms
- Improve lighting in the parking area
- Provide ample electrical outlets in the entire building (especially in the kitchen)
- Replace existing carpet flooring in rooms that support dance programming. Use either wood or other hard surfaces.
- Better sound deadening for bigger rooms to mitigate noisy group chatter
- Provide ample game tables, at least four billiards tables that can transform into ping pong tables
- Consider small coffee shop with drive-thru plus cooking classes
- Wood shop / makerspace









Management Overview

- This is an Event Center not a Recreation Center
 - No plans to replicate senior center activities
 - Use of the facility is primarily for residence exception being rented times that help support the center financially
 - Do wish for this to be a place for residents to socialize outside of the clubhouses
 - Members of the clubhouses are using this facility
 - This is operated by the Town not the POA more education is needed here for that to be clear to the residence
- Providing a guest speaker series is important
- Would like to better utilize the space
- Accommodating dance is a goal, while providing space for billiards is not
- Would like a summary of the Top 5 results from the surveys
- The Center is considered a backup EOC if a catastrophic event occurred architect informed the group that this building is not designed to be occupied during a storm event but could help support afterwards

Schedule/Occupancy

- 9:00-12:00
- 1:00-4:00
- 5:00-9:00
- This works well with groups as they leave for lunch and dinner
- Also means there is no parking overlap
- Currently unable to accommodate some member groups and non-profits
- Late August -Christmas and January -April are the busy times
- Maintenance occurs between Christmas and January
- Currently at 85% of full capacity with 15% remaining open
- Facility is open to the members on Saturday between 9:00-1:00
 - o This may not be fully understood by the members
- Booking for group activities is done for the entire year

Needs as seen by management

- A 4-8 person space would allow for 45 additional reservations
- The drop off loop is a valued amenity
- Site lighting is being replace and additional is being added by BEMC this year
- There is a need for additional handicapped parking spaces
 - This may be above that required by code due to the Center's population age
- Green space between the building and the parking area is desired even though it requires additional walking distance

Wish List

- Soften the facade on the Community Center
- Larger doors into small spaces
 - o Door frames require constant painting
- HVAC controls on a dashboard thermostats are constantly being adjusted by the users
- Additional storage for any new program spaces
- A full review of the Center's mechanical system with recommendations on long term repair/replacement
- A full review to the Center's audio visual
 - Currently a mix of Creston and Exron

Next Steps

- Participate in work session with the Mayor and Council
- Show the top 5 results from surveys
- Show diagrammatic solution for providing additional space
- Discuss "Ball Park" or "Order of Magnitude" budget
- Discuss "Ball Park" schedule

Operations

- What is the percentage of time the facility is currently booked
- What is the current cost per square foot for commercial construction
- 1900 new homes are proposed for the town
- 75% of the town belong to Clubs within gates of St. James
 - o Clubs offer exercise equipment, pool, tennis courts, etc...
- The center is open for day of voting during general elections
 - Have been asked to do early voting but it impacts too many activities for too long a time period
- The center is used for health days flu shots, etc...

Dance

- Currently use Rooms 1 & 2
 - o Accommodate about 7 couples at a time
 - o Room 2 is often booked
- Need a room ½ the size of Multi-purpose Room A or 1725sf
- For couples dance a square shaped room is best
- For line dancing the shape doesn't matter
 - o 15-30 people (9 participants on the day we were in the building)
 - o Room 1 appears to be able to accommodate 12 line dancers
- Tap is 10-12 people
 - o A 900sf room works well
- Need a hard floor with hard wood being preferred
 - Portable dance floor for the Multi-purpose rooms is difficult because it has a ramped edge around the perimeter
- HVAC works well
- Would like Saturday use

Card & Tile Games

- Multiple games being played in one space is good
 - No need for dividers
 - o The group likes sharing time with one another
 - Room 2 or 3 will accommodate 6 4 person tables

Board Games

- Works best with 4hrs of use
 - o This allows either a longer game to be played or two shorter games
 - The preferred weekday time would be 6-10 as a 5:00 start time makes it difficult for people to arrive
- Would like Saturday use
- Role playing games need quiet to be played
- Counter is needed to display the games to be played but no long-term storage needs

Billiards

- 2-4 tables 8' size would be sufficient
- 100 players currently in the men's league
- Could be combined with a lounge
- Could be combined with ping pong (tables that convert to either use)

Crafts

Would benefit from lockable storage so participants could leave their items

Other Activities

- Permanent stage for performances, concerts, comedy skits, etc..
- POA meetings
- Cooking classes
- Mixology classes
- Art Room for painting, drawing, jewelry making
 - Space would benefit from a hard floor
- Wood working shop space
- Model railroading requires a dedicated space due the model taking over a year to complete (about 25 people)
- More of a Clubhouse Feel
 - o Place for 70-90 people to gather
 - Bar/caterer's kitchen/cozy seating






EXISTING SITE ANALYSIS



Addition of additional wooden floor dance space. Diane Norton's line dance class on Tuesday limits the number of attendees because there is not enough space. We try to schedule dance workshops to teach additional partner pattern dances. The only time the wood dance floors are available is on Saturday mornings if we book several months in advance. When Diane cancels her Tuesday night classes, we try to grab the room for the one off dance workshop. We are considering starting a pattern dance club for St. James but there is no space available on a regular basis. Our only alternative is to ask St. James residents to pay Troon for dance opportunities. It is generally accepted that the mental and physical aspects of dancing improves the quality of life for those who participate. We will provide our own music sources and speakers. The dance floor space needs to be large enough to allow ballroom style, large dances that move in a circular pattern for a twenty or more couples. This would provide a service not available even for pay in the area. Previous people have tried to start ballroom dance clubs. These have failed due to lack of space to dance once they learned and the lack of space to hold lessons on a sufficiently frequent (weekly) time period to make the teaching effective. We have found with our dance workshops successful only if we could hold classes weekly. Between our personal schedules and availability of the dance space at the community center, we have only been able to hold 3 workshops over the past 2 years with another workshop planned for March of 2025. Note that while we also teach at the twice monthly game club, there is much less need for specialized space for playing games and cards. We can get together with friends at the various houses to play games and cards - if fact we play complex games with other couples at least 8 times per month, in addition to the formal St. James

Q6 Please rank the following features by how important they are to your household?










People can do those activities at home. Do not replace already available spaces such as outdoor spaces that are available at Woodlands or Waterway parks. Do not invest in equipment that needs upgrades and maintenance that are readily available elsewhere - such as pool tables that can be found at local bars, gym equipment or restaurant/ coffee bars that are available at Troon or in Midway Commons shopping center. Event space for parties and dances are what is needed most. Troon parties are much more expensive than Activities Committee parties. Further renting dance or celebration event space is cost prohibitive at Troon and even the Moose Lodge. Keeping the Event Center open on Thursday nights might be an option to consider. My husband and I teach partner dance s . We severely limit the number of workshops and attendees we allow due to floor space size and dance floor availability. While the Event staff is very accommodating, it is difficult to book dance floor space multiple weeks in a row. Holding instructions once per month is too far apart to have people learn. We are aware of two other efforts to teach couple partner dances that failed - a root cause in our opinion is that they tried to teach only once per month.
