

Budget Highlights

- Property Tax Rate to stay at .06¢
 - NO TAX INCREASE
 - 1 cent tax to fund disaster recovery continues

Without the appropriations of fund balance, or the Grant revenue,
There is an overall decrease of 2.3%

Although the net decrease is 2.3%, there is a slight uptick in property taxes, and an 100% increase in estimated interest earnings.
